## Zonta EducateZ Scholarship Application

Thank you for your interest in the Zonta EducateZ Scholarship. The Zonta Foothills Club of Boulder County and The Zonta Foothills Foundation, the creators of this scholarship are committed to helping women who face significant financial barriers to higher education. We want to make returning to or staying in school a reality. The Zonta EducateZ Scholarship awards are made to further the post-secondary education of a woman student who:

- wants to return to school
- faces significant financial barriers to attending a college, university or any accredited institution
- is committed to becoming self-sufficient through education.

To **qualify for this scholarship** award, you must:

- be a resident of the State of Colorado
- have graduated from high school or have earned a GED
- be admitted to a two or four-year accredited college, university, or trade school
- demonstrate financial need
- complete the required essay
- participate in an interview if requested.

If you are awarded the Zonta EducateZ Scholarship, you agree to:

- maintain a “C” GPA
- update the donor at the end of each semester on your progress and the impact that this award has had on your ability to attend this post-secondary institution
- allow Zonta Foothills Club to use your name and picture in our promotional materials and fund-raising efforts to promote this scholarship and Zonta’s work
- Meet with the Zonta EducateZ Committee to update us on your progress, challenges and interest in reapplying.

The Selection Committee will review your application and, if approved, a check for the amount awarded (up to \$2,000, \$1,000 per semester) will be directly sent directly to the institution you are attending. It will be available for any education-related expenses.

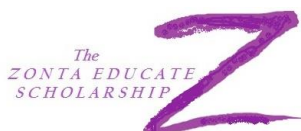
**Applications for the Zonta EducateZ Scholarship must be received by August 1, 2017.**
